The Association provides a social network for past and present officers of the Royal Australian Navy (RAN) who primarily have a surface warfare focus however its charter includes Officers of all specialisations who have served at sea since WW2. It maintains very close links with the RAN and particularly with the Centre of Maritime Warfare Training, HMAS WATSON.
